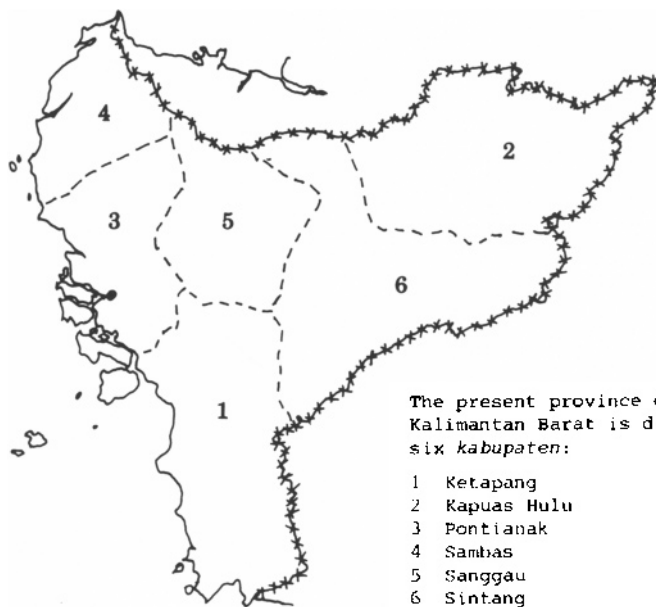

ETHNIC SKETCH-MAP

MALAYS: all along the Kapuas river, along the lower reaches of most of its main tributaries, and along the west coast.

CHINESE are concentrated in the main towns along the west coast and in the northwestern part of the province.

KANTUK DAYAKS are spread along the middle and upper Kapuas and a number of its tributaries.

The vague term "LAND DAYAKS" comprises a number of insufficiently known Dayak groups.
