Those approaching the book from the Greek side should have little trouble. I note only that references to Arrian (Arr.) are always to the *Anabasis*, that the Hellenica Oxyrhynchia (apart from the newest fragments, *Studia Papyrologica* 15, 1976, 55-76) are cited from Bartoletti's Teubner, and that Photius' epitome of Ktesias is cited by Henry's edition of 1947 (the marginal figures in Jacoby, *FGH* 688 FF 14-16).
