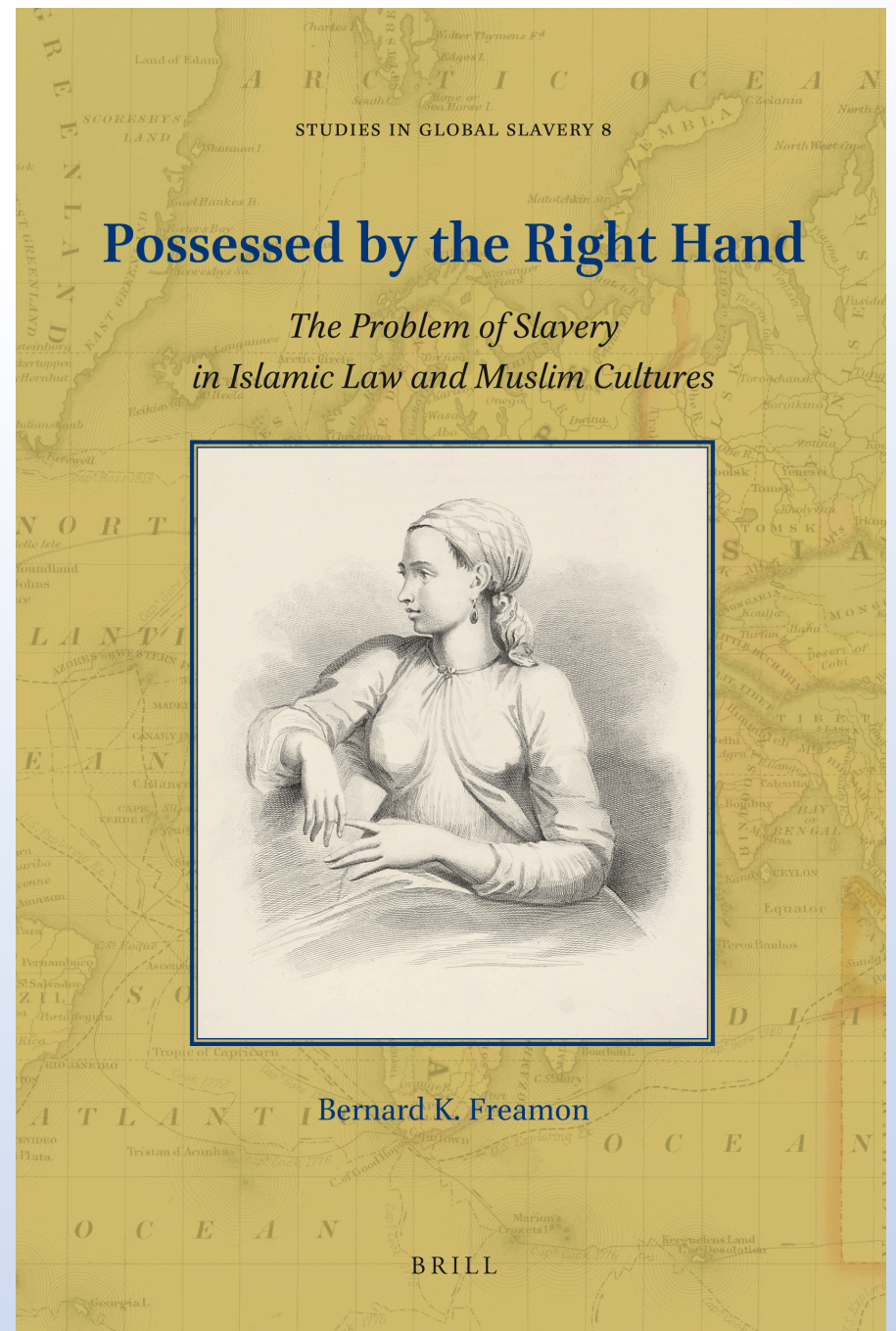


# CAAS Distinguished Alumni Lecture
