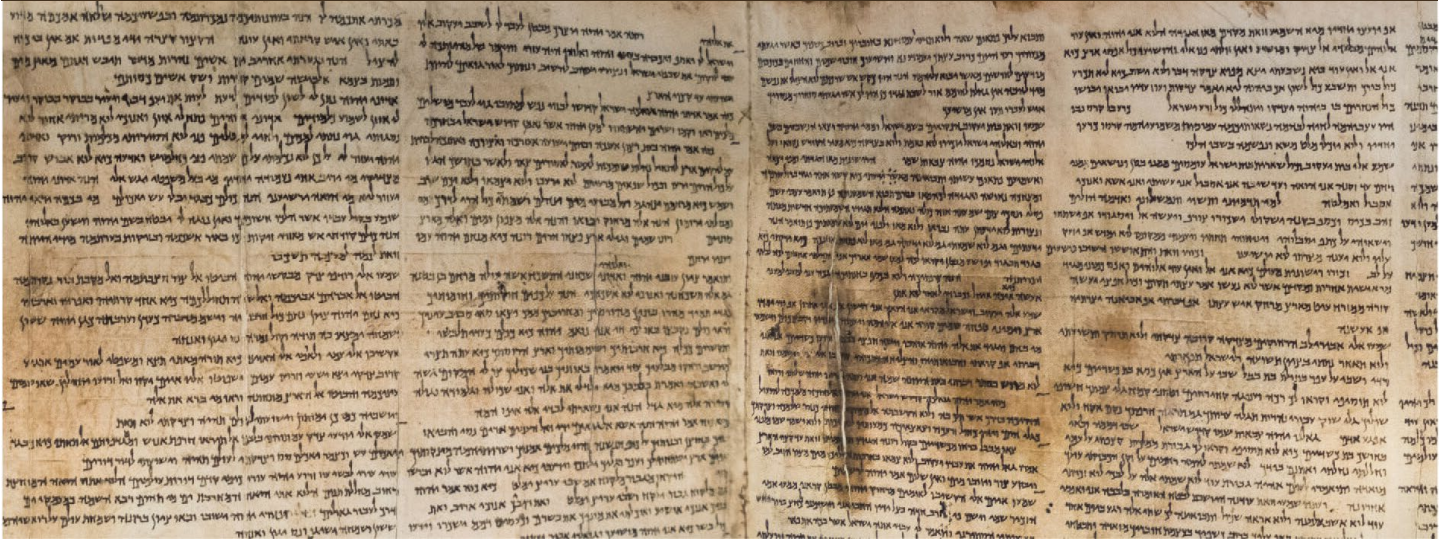

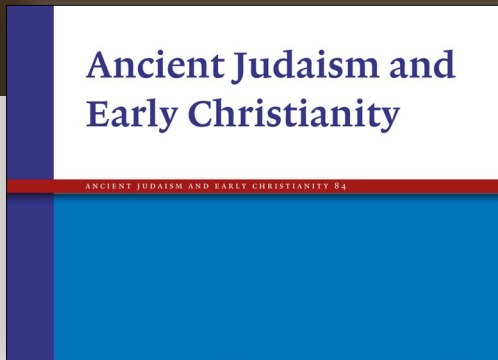

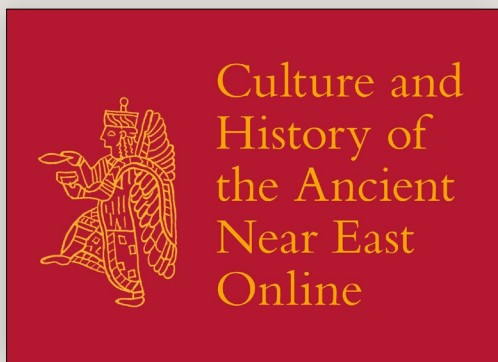
Ancient Judaism and Early Christianity

Ancient Judaism & Early Christianity, established in 1976, explores the intersections and controversies between Judaism and Christianity in the early centuries CE. The series publishes monographs and essay collections, with recent works focusing on figures like Josephus, the Jewish context of Paul's writings, and the historical Jesus. It has maintained an average of two volumes per year over the past five years.



Novum Testamentum Supplements Online

Supplements to *Novum Testamentum* publishes monographs and essay collections in New Testament studies, focusing on text-critical, philological, and exegetical research. It situates early Christian texts—both canonical and non-canonical—within the broader Jewish and Graeco-Roman contexts. Notable titles include *Perspectives on New Testament Textual Criticism* (by well-known authors), *Studien zur Entstehungsgeschichte und Intention des Kolosserbriefs*, and *Philo of Alexandria - An Exegete for His Time*.



Culture and History of the Ancient Near East Online

Culture and History of the Ancient Near East is a leading forum for exploring all aspects of ancient Near Eastern civilizations. Covering a wide range of topics—including religion, history, language, literature, thought, science, art, and architecture—the series maintains high scholarly standards and innovative approaches. It publishes monographs and collected volumes in English, French, and German.



Vetus Testamentum Supplements Online

The *Supplements to Vetus Testamentum* series explores all aspects of Old Testament study, including Septuaginta and Ugaritic research, Hebrew studies, and ancient Israelite history. It includes monographs and collective volumes, including proceedings from the International Organization for the Study of the Old Testament's Triennial Congresses. Notable titles are *Seconding Sinai - The Development of Mosaic Discourse in Second Temple Judaism* (by well-known authors), *The Book of Daniel, Volume 1: Composition and Reception*, and *Studies in the Hebrew Bible, Qumran, and the Septuagint*.

The Brill Book Archives are published in two parts:

BBA 1 (titles published 2000-2006) and BBA 2 (titles published pre-2000).

The Archives are available as one entire collection (over 15.000 titles), as either part 1 or 2, or as separate subject collections (12 subjects in total).

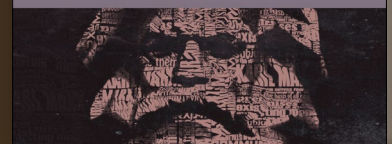
