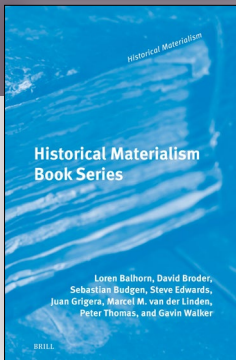

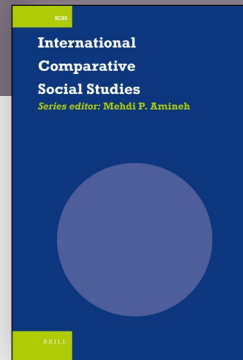

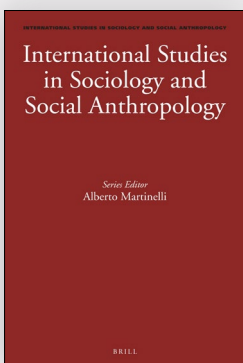
Historical Materialism Book Series

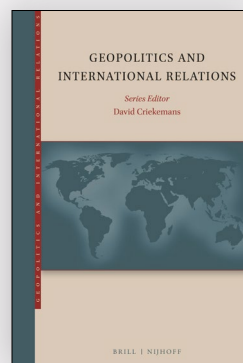
International Comparative Social Studies

Also of note are the series *Studies in Critical Social Sciences*, *Global Populisms*, *Critical Latin America*, and *Youth in a Globalizing World*.

BBA 1 (titles published 2000-2006) and BBA 2 (titles published pre-2000).

The Archives are available as one entire collection (over 15.000 titles), as either part 1 or 2, or as separate subject collections (12 subjects in total).

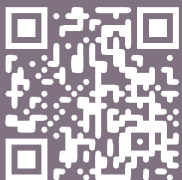

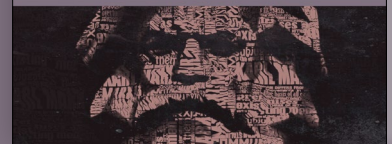
